Nadia Lichtig is a German-French curator, researcher and artist based in Montpellier, South of France. She currently holds a professorship at the MOCO (www.moco.art, director Nicolas Bourriaud) and is attached to the Ecole doctorale franco-allemande Aix-Marseille University / Eberhard Karls Universität Tübingen (<https://ecole-doctorale-354.univ-amu.fr/fr/college-doctoral-franco-allemand>). Her research is situated at the intersection between Subjectivity, Art and Science. Between 2020 and 2023 Lichtig is the co-organizer of a cycle of talks and an exhibition at Aix Marseille Université (France) and Universiteit van Amsterdam (Netherlands) questioning the representation of oblivion in the arts. In 2021/22 she organizes a cycle of performances and poetry readings at the Galerie for Gegenwartskunst in Freiburg im Breisgau. In autumn/winter 2020 she co-organized with Katharina Schmidt « Staying in the Trouble with Painting » an exhibition taking place in the public space in Marseille in the context of the Manifesta 13. Between 2017 and 2020 she was the curator of a cycle of exhibitions at the German Cultural Center in Montpellier.

Lichtig studied at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts de Paris, France where she graduated with honors and subsequently assisted Mike Kelley in Los Angeles. Her multi-layered research is including artistic research, curating and writing, questioning art as a source of possibilities to examine the regime of our perceptions and our ability to decipher the present. Before being a regular professor at the MOCO in Montpellier, Lichtig taught at the Shrishti School of Art and Technology, Bangalore, India as a visiting professor in 2006, at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts of Valence in 2007. As a musician Lichtig has collaborated with musicians who are also visual artists, such as Nina Canal (Ut) and Michael Moorley (The dead C). Nadia Lichtig worked and works under several group names and pseudonyms.
